### **Dead Sea**

Departure from all Tiberias hotels at 08.30

Dead Sea is the lowest point on earth. Biblically, this region was a place of refuge for King David and one of the world's first health resorts for Herod the Great. An assortment of mineral waters of various qualities is used for therapeutic and cosmetic treatments, as well as for manufacturing of the famous Dead Sea cosmetics line.

Visit of Ein Gedi Botanical Garden, real oasis in the desert then proceed to Massada. Ascend by cable car to the top of mount, a rugged natural fortress of majestic beauty and history. Massada became a famous landmark after the first Jewish-Roman war. A siege was laid around the fortress by troops of the 10th Roman legion and when defeat became imminent it led to a mass suicide by the 158 Jewish Sicarii defenders of Massada.

Enjoy the spa facilities of your hotel and float at the Dead Sea.

### **Jerusalem Old City**

Departure from all Tiberias hotels at 08.30

Start with a panoramic view of the old city of Jerusalem from Mt. of Olives. Proceed to a walking tour of the Old City, starting with a stroll from Jaffa Gate through the Armenian Quarter and the restored Jewish Quarter. Through the Roman Cardo, discover the Herodian mansions and continue to the Western Wall (Kotel), one of the holiest Jewish sites on earth. A remnant of the Herodian wall that once enclosed and supported the Second Temple. Walk the path of the famed Via Dolorosa and visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

Enjoy a sound and light show at the Tower of David.

### **Jerusalem New City**

Visit of Yad Vashem Museum and the New City.

Go on to the Shrine of the Book at Israel Museum where the Dead Sea scrolls are exhibited including a model of the Second Temple.

### **Tel-Aviv**

Departure from Jerusalem hotel at 08.30

See the magnificent of Tel Aviv. In 2003, UNESCO declared "The White City", the unique urban and historical fabric of Tel Aviv, as a World Cultural Heritage Site. The tour provides a taste of the modern architectural styles and techniques of the 1930's along the famous Rothschild Boulevard. The 'White City' is truly the cornerstone of Tel Aviv, where every doorpost and terrace holds a wealth of history. Enjoy the charming picturesque sites of Tel Aviv Open Market, Neve Tzedek, the very first neighborhood in Tel Aviv, and Old Jaffa.
